

Support for Future Delivery Window

Enhancing the EDGE function that enables users to hold an order for future release, a "Delivery Window" date range can now be specified in the originating order to determine when the order shipment should arrive at the customer's location.

When a future delivery window is specified, EDGE can then automatically calculate the release date based on the value for the new order-related project setting described in [New Project Setting for Future Order Release](#).



Note:

Currently, this feature only applies to orders received in EDGE via the OpenTools "Order Import" message.
